## **Temporary Road Closure - East Fremantle's George Street Festival 2023**

On Sunday 3 December 2023 from 6.00am to 9.00pm, George Street (between East Street and Duke Street) will be closed to all vehicle traffic for the East Fremantle's George Street Festival.

Residents and visitors are asked to please ensure that all vehicles are removed from George Street, side streets and from private driveways by 6.00am Sunday. To maintain the safety of festival staff, suppliers and patrons, once set up commences no vehicles are able to move from private driveways and properties until the road is opened again at 9.00pm. Should you anticipate that you will require your vehicle on the Sunday, it is recommended to park on an adjoining street outside of the event site prior to 6.00am Sunday morning.

Please be aware that any unauthorised vehicles remaining on George Street within the event site after 6.00am, may need to be towed if directly impacting on the event. There will be temporary fencing and 'No Parking' signage placed along George Street and side streets from 1.00pm Saturday 2 December.

On festival day, to minimise disruption to local residents and people passing through East Fremantle, traffic will continue to flow on both East Street and Duke Street.
