GREENWASTE COLLECTIONS

(REMEMBER: please DO NOT place junk waste items out for this collection).

The following items **WILL** be collected:

Tree and shrub prunings up to:

- ✓ 1.5 metre in length
- ✓ 350mm in diameter
- ✓ two trailer loads (6x4 trailer size) or 2 cubic metres of greenwaste.

The following items **WILL NOT** be collected:

- ✗ bags or boxes of leaves or grass clippings
- ✗ dug out lawn
- ✗ general rubbish, junk or whitegoods
- ✗ leaves and lawn clippings (place in green bin)
- ✗ sand and soil materials
- ✗ weeds and root materials.



JUNK & WHITE GOODS / METAL COLLECTIONS

(REMEMBER: please DO NOT place green waste items out for this collection).

For whitegoods and other items still usable, please contact Anglicare for collection on (08) 6253 3508.

The following items **WILL** be collected:

- ✓ e-waste (electrical items and computer hardware)
- ✓ general junk
- ✓ mattresses
- ✓ scrap (furniture & other household items)
- ✓ timber products (up to 1.5 metres in length)
- ✓ whitegoods – fridges, stoves, etc (up to 1.5 metres in length).

The following items **WILL NOT** be collected:

- ✗ **NO** asbestos products
- ✗ **NO** batteries
- ✗ **NO** bricks, sand or building rubble
- ✗ **NO** car bodies or vehicle parts
- ✗ **NO** cement or concrete
- ✗ **NO** gas cylinders
- ✗ **NO** greenwaste, no bags with leaves
- ✗ **NO** food stuff or domestic rubbish
- ✗ **NO** paints, chemicals, oils
- ✗ **NO** plate glass or shower screens
- ✗ **NO** stump or palm logs
- ✗ **NO** trees exceeding 1.5m
- ✗ **NO** tyres.

Please place bulk rubbish on the verge in **FOUR PILES** without obstructing footpaths.



NOTE: Doors **MUST** be detached from fridges & freezers

The truck collecting recyclable metals is a separate truck from the general junk collection vehicle.

Your cooperation will ensure your collection is removed on time

PLEASE DO

- ✓ Place your waste neatly on the verge no more than seven (7) days prior to the scheduled start date for your Area.
- ✓ Place your waste on the verge by **Monday 6:00am** on the **scheduled start date** for your Area as the contractor will only check the verge once.
- ✓ Allow 5 – 7 working days for collection.

PLEASE DO NOT

- ✗ Obstruct the footpath, your normal bin services or the line of sight of pedestrians, cyclists or cars.
- ✗ Place your waste inside your property line.
- ✗ Place your waste on the other verges as it will not be collected from vacant properties and land or public reserves.
- ✗ Tie your greenwaste in bundles.

As verge collections are picked up by mechanical means, please DON'T place your waste next to trees, power poles, walls, street signs, sprinklers, fire hydrants or water meters as these may get damaged.
