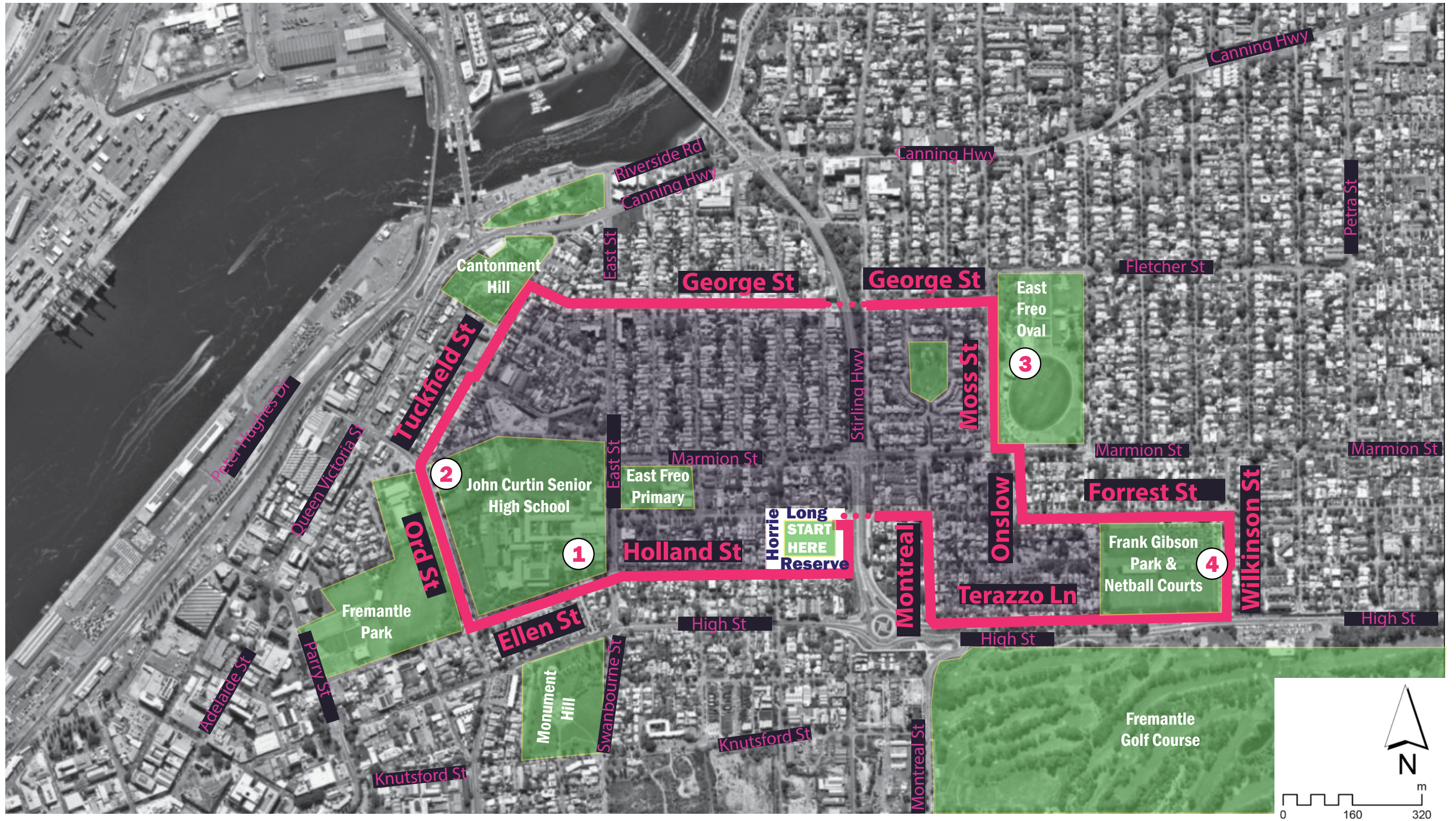

This aerial map of Fremantle, Western Australia, illustrates a proposed pink walking route. The route begins at the 'Long Horrie Reserve', marked with a 'START HERE' sign. It proceeds east along George St, then turns south onto Moss St, followed by a westward turn onto Terazzo Ln. From there, it goes north on Wilkinson St, west on Forrest St, north on Marmion St, west on East St, north on Tuckfield St, west on Ord St, south through Fremantle Park, and finally east on Ellen St, returning to the starting point. Four numbered stops are indicated: 1 is located on East St near John Curtin Senior High School; 2 is on Ord St near Fremantle Park; 3 is on Moss St near East Freo Oval; and 4 is on Terazzo Ln near Frank Gibson Park & Netball Courts. The map also shows the Fremantle Golf Course to the south and various other streets such as Canning Hwy, Stirling Hwy, and Knutsford St. A scale bar and north arrow are provided in the bottom right corner.
