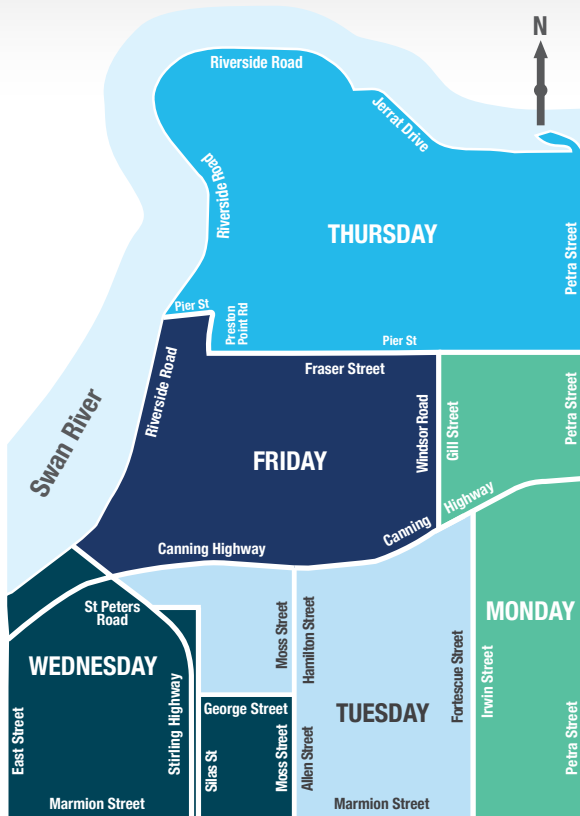

General Waste and Recycling



General Waste only (dark green)

Putting your bins out for collection



Place bins on kerb by **6am** on collection day



Maximum weight of each bin is **70kg**



Avoid overfilling to ensure lid can close

FOGO kitchen caddy information

Your kitchen caddy makes sorting your food organics in the kitchen simple.

- Use your caddy *nude* (no liner), or
- Use a certified compostable liner

Replenish your compostable caddy liners

Residents are eligible for two free packs of compostable liners per financial year, upon presentation of photo ID at the Town Hall, 135 Canning Highway.

Additional liners and kitchen caddies can be purchased from the Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle.

Your food organics and garden organics are turned into compost.

FOGO compost is available for \$5 per 25L bag from the Fremantle Recycling Centre.

'COMPOSTABLE' CUPS & PACKAGING

Some compostable packaging contains PFAS -
a 'forever chemical' that contaminates compost.
FOGO systems also can't separate compostable
from non-compostable items.

LOOSE

Items should always be loose. Bagged items cannot be recycled.



RINSE

Empty and rinse your recyclables to reduce contamination.



LIDS OFF

Remove lids from bottles and containers.

Fremantle Recycling Centre

Residents of the Town of East Fremantle have access to the Fremantle Recycling Centre.

To access the Centre, please provide:

1. Your current Fremantle Recycling Centre letter
2. Current photo ID* showing your East Fremantle address (e.g. driver's licence)**

Without both the above letter and matching photo proof of residency, access to the Centre will be denied.

*If your photo ID does not show your current address, please also bring a rates notice or utility bill to verify residency.

**For residential use only (no commercial access)

Unlimited entry for recyclables listed below (unless otherwise indicated):

- Aerosol cans
- Batteries (vehicle)
- Bread tags (plastic only)
- Can clips
- Cardboard
- Clean and unbroken blocks, bricks, and pavers
- Clean garden organics (up to 1.5m in length and 30cm in diameter, one trailer load per day, fees apply for additional loads)
- Clothing, shoes, and bags (good condition)
- Coffee Pods
- Contact lenses and packaging including plastic film, pods and cardboard packaging (not contact lens solution bottles)
- Cooking oil (up to 20L)
- Electrical appliances and electrical cables
- Electronic waste; computers, TVs and accessories
- Household batteries
- Mattresses (fees apply)
- Medicinal blister packs (empty)
- Mobile phones
- Motor oil (up to 20L)
- Plastic bottle lids
- Plastic plant pots
- Polystyrene
- Printer cartridges
- Razor blades and packaging
- Recyclables (same as your yellow-lid bin)
- Stationary (new or near new)
- Scrap metal
- Thongs (flip flops)
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes, floss packets and electric toothbrush heads
- Tyres (fees apply)
- Whitegoods
- X-rays

Household Hazardous Waste Facility

Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle

A limit of 20kg or 20 litres per material type.

The following waste materials are covered under the HHW Program:

- Acids
- Aerosols – CFC based
- Aerosols, flammable – paint and lacquers
- Aerosols, flammable – pesticide
- Alkali
- Arsenic based products
- Batteries – household, dry cell
- Cyanides
- Engine coolants and glycols
- Fire extinguishers – non-Halon
- Flammable liquids – hydrocarbons and fuels
- Flammable solids
- Flares
- Fluorescent tubes, CFL and light fittings
- Gas cylinders – other
- Gas cylinders – propane
- General household chemicals e.g. cleaners
- Heavy metal compounds
- Inorganic oxidising agents – e.g. pool chlorine
- Low level radioactive substances
e.g. smoke detectors
- Mercury – elemental
- Organic peroxides
- Paint – metal based, other, including isocyanates and amines, recyclable, solvent based, including resins and adhesives, water based
- PCB materials
- Pesticides – non-Schedule X
- Pesticides – Schedule X
- Solvents – halogenated
- Toxics
- Unknown chemicals if they are in a secure, sealed, chemical-resistant container.

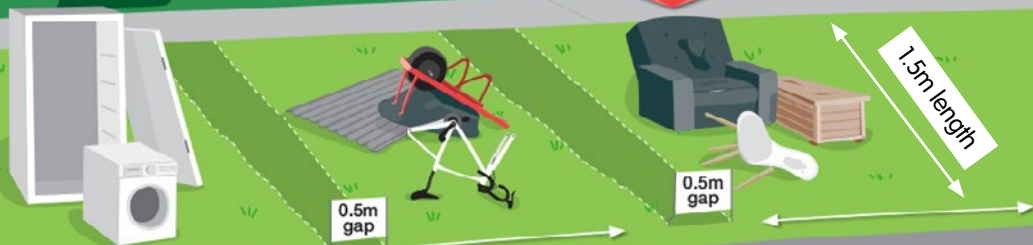

Please place your waste on the verge by **6am Monday of the scheduled start dates** as the contractor will only service your verge once. **Please ensure waste is placed no earlier than seven days prior to collection** (only for residential properties).

Accepted Materials:

- ✓ Barbecues (not gas bottles)
- ✓ Bicycles
- ✓ Bulky toys
- ✓ E-waste (TVs, computers, accessories)
- ✓ Fencing (timber and steel only)
- ✓ Floor coverings (linoleum, carpet)
- ✓ Fridges/freezers (doors removed)
- ✓ Garden hoses
- ✓ Household furniture (no glass)
- ✓ Mattress/es and Mattress bases
- ✓ Scrap metal
- ✓ Plant pots
- ✓ Small electrical goods
- ✓ Timber (not garden waste; max. 1.5m length)
- ✓ White goods (doors removed)
- ✓ Wire/strapping

Place these items in separate piles:

- E-waste*
- Mattresses*
- White goods (fridge and freezer doors must be removed).

*E-waste & mattresses may be collected separately from other bulk waste on a different day.

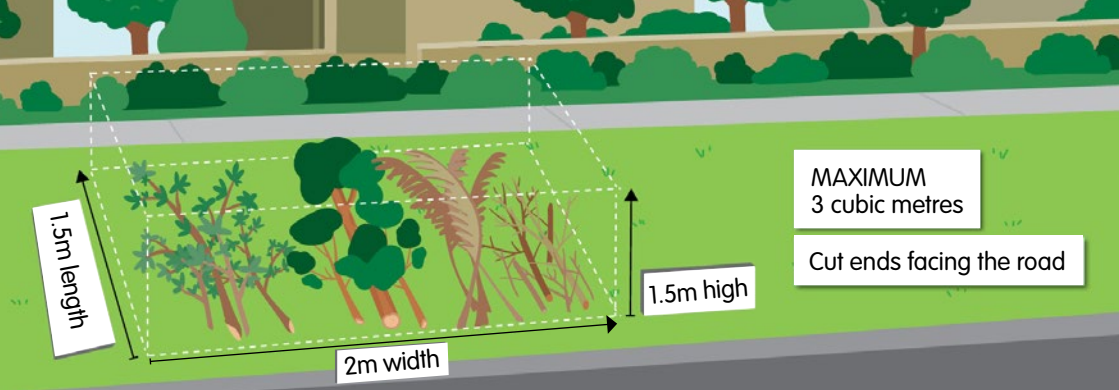
Non accepted materials:

- ✗ No asbestos products
- ✗ No batteries
- ✗ No building materials (brick, rubble, concrete, tiles, pavers, sand etc.)
- ✗ No car oil or fuel
- ✗ No food
- ✗ No gas cylinders, aerosols or fire extinguishers
- ✗ No glass panels (tabletops, mirrors or windowpanes)
- ✗ No hazardous materials (flammable, toxic or corrosive liquids)
- ✗ No paint
- ✗ No dirt, soil, sand, mulch or garden organics
- ✗ No tyres
- ✗ No vehicles, car bodies, or car parts

Bulk & White/Metal Goods

Please refer to the Town's website for collection dates.

Tip: Set a phone reminder to put bulk waste out by 6am Monday of your scheduled week!



Please place your waste on the verge by **6am Monday of the scheduled start dates** as the contractor will only service your verge once. **Please ensure waste is placed no earlier than one week prior to collection** (only for residential properties).

Accepted materials:

- Maximum of three (3) cubic metres
- Tree trunks up to 1.5 metres in length and no more than 30cm in diameter
- Palm fronds
- Branches and shrub prunings.

Pest Alert

Before disposing of green waste, inspect for unusual pests or damage. If you see signs of Polyphagous shot-hole borer, keep the material on your property and report it. Suspect fruit fly or unusual insects? These can also be reported.

- Sand and or soil
- Lawn sods
- Coppers logs
- Sleepers
- Household rubbish
- Plastic
- Recyclables
- Bags of grass or weeds.

Bulk Green Waste

Green waste can also be disposed of at the Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle – one trailer load per day, proof of residency and Fremantle Recycling letter required on entry. Visit fremantle.wa.gov.au/frc for more information.
