George Street Designated Heritage Area

Notice is hereby given that the Town of East Fremantle proposes to:

- (i) designate a Heritage Area to be known as the George Street Designated Heritage Area;
- (ii) adopt for the Heritage Area a Local Planning Policy (LPP) to be known as LPP 3.1.6 – George Street Designated Heritage Area which sets out the following:
 - a) a map showing the boundaries of the Designated Heritage Area;
 - b) a statement of heritage significance for the area; and
 - c) a record of places of heritage significance in the heritage area (Appendix 1 to LPP 3.1.6).

A map of the proposed George Street Designated Heritage Area and LPP 3.1.6 – George Street Designated Heritage Area setting out and explaining the proposal are available for inspection on the Town's website and at the Town Hall, 135 Canning Highway, East Fremantle during office hours up to and including **Friday, 15 November 2019.**
