

Prize Draw Terms and Conditions

General

The promoter of the 2026 Town of East Fremantle Hard Copy Newsletter Re-naming Competition Prize Draw ("Competition") is TOWN OF EAST FREMANTLE (ABN: 80 0523 650 32) of 135 Canning Highway, East Fremantle WA 6158 ("Promoter").

Details on eligibility, how to enter, and the prize for the Competition are set out in these terms and conditions of entry ("Terms and Conditions"). By entering this Competition, entrants are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.

To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other reference to this Competition, these Terms and Conditions prevail.

Who Can Enter

- Any person who is 18+ years of age AND is an East Fremantle resident, business owner or community member AND has submitted a suggestion for a new name for the Town's printed newsletter AND who has fulfilled the requirements set out in these Terms and Conditions is eligible to enter the Competition.
- Employees of the Promoter or its associated agencies and companies, and their immediate family members, are not eligible to enter this Competition.
- Current Elected Members and their families are not eligible to enter this Competition.
- The Promoter may, in their absolute discretion, disqualify an entrant for any reason, including breaching these Terms and Conditions, or acceptable or reasonable standards of safety, conduct, and respect.

How to Enter

- Eligible persons may enter the Competition by submitting a name suggestion, that represents what they love the most about East Fremantle, for the Town's printed newsletter.
- Eligible persons can enter up to two name suggestions, which count as one (1) entry.
- Multiple entries are not permitted.
- Each entry must be between one and three words.
- Any submission that is deemed offensive, inappropriate, discriminatory, defamatory, or otherwise harmful will not be accepted.

- The Promoter has the discretion to deem incomprehensible, illegible, non-compliant, and incomplete entries invalid.

Number of Entries Permitted

- Each submission counts as one (1) entry.
- Multiple entries are not allowed.

Prize on Offer

- One (1) winner will receive 1 x \$150 Gift Card to spend at an East Fremantle business of the winner's choice. This will be decided between the Promoter and the Winner after the draw.
- The prize is non-transferable, non-exchangeable, and not redeemable for cash.
- If the specified prize becomes unavailable for any reason, the Promoter may, but is under no obligation to, substitute a prize of like or equal value.
- Any tax payable as a result of the prize being awarded or received will be the prize winner's responsibility.
- The Promoter takes no responsibility for the loss of the prize or the inability of the prize winner to use the prize due to incorrect or imprecise delivery details provided by the prize winner or otherwise.
- The Promoter makes no representations or warranties as to the quality, suitability, or merchantability of the prize.

Competition Period & Draw Details

- The competition commences on Saturday 17 January 2026 at 9:00 AM AWST and closes on Saturday 31 January 2026 at 10.00 AM AWST ("Promotional Period").
- Entries must be received by the Promoter during the Promotional Period to be valid. Entries received after this time will not be included in the Competition, and the Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost, misdirected, incorrect, or invalid entries.
- The winner will be determined by the Town on Monday 2 February.
- The winner will be notified by email by the Town within three business days.

Publicity of Competition

- It is a condition of entry in the Competition that the Promoter has the right to publish the name, image, voice, photograph, or video of the winning entrant

("Materials") for any matter incidental to the Competition or the promotion or marketing of the Promoter and Contractor.

- The Promoter may use such Materials in any medium, including, without limitation, on its website or other electronic means, in any reasonable manner.

Privacy & Miscellaneous

- The Promoter will collect, use, and manage personal information provided in each entry in accordance with its privacy policy.
- Competition entries will be deleted within three months of the competition closing date.
- Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, the Promoter (including its officers, employees, and agents) excludes all liability (including negligence) for any personal injury; or any loss or damage (including loss of opportunity) whether direct, indirect, special, or consequential, arising in any way out of the Competition, including, but not limited to, liabilities arising from or in connection with:
 - any technical difficulties or equipment malfunction (whether or not under the Promoter's control);
 - any theft, unauthorized access, or third-party interference;
 - any entry or prize claim that is late, lost, altered, damaged, or misdirected (whether or not after their receipt by the Promoter) due to any reason beyond the reasonable control of the Promoter;
 - any variation in prize value to that stated in these Terms and Conditions;
 - any tax liability incurred by a winner or entrant;
 - redemption of the prize; and
 - participation in the Competition.

Cancellation

- The Promoter reserves the right to suspend, cancel, or otherwise close the competition earlier than stated in these Terms and Conditions for safety, security, technical failures, or any other causes that affect the proper administration, fairness, or security of the Competition.
