1. East Fremantle Community Park (EFCP)

2. River Wall Restoration

The deteriorating state of the river wall is a pressing concern. It affects not only the safety and aesthetics of our foreshore but also our environmental resilience. I will advocate strongly for increased lobbying to the state government to secure additional grant funding.

3. Urban Tree Canopy Management

I will ensure that tree replacement and new planting are actively monitored, and will push for a budget allocation in 2026/27 to support the planting of 5,000 new trees and shrubs.

4. Support for Local Businesses

Small businesses are the heartbeat of East Fremantle. I will advocate for a sustainable pathway to reduce commercial lease rates over the next four years.

Over the past four years, I’ve been proud to contribute to a number of subcommittee’s that have strengthened our town. As chair of the Audit Committee, I’ve promoted financial transparency and responsible budgeting. As chair of the Works Committee, I’ve supported improvements to public spaces, roads, and facilities.
