Notification of Riverside Road Reconstruction and Rehabilitation Works

On behalf of the Town of East Fremantle, Civcon Civil & Project Management will be carrying out road reconstruction and rehabilitation works along Riverside Road, East Fremantle.

Preliminary works will commence on Monday 23 March 2020, with site mobilisation to commence on Thursday 26 March 2020.

How long will this take?

Programme of works is scheduled to be completed within ten (10) weeks. This however, is dependent on the weather and resources, which may mean the project could extend beyond this. Works will be undertaken during weekdays between the hours of 7:00am – 5:00pm.



Works will be undertaken in four separate stages. During stage 1-3, the existing pavement seal will remain intact.

Stage 1

Riverside Road will be closed between the southern end of the Leeuwin boat ramp car park and Dôme café. Northern portion of Dôme café carpark closed. Local access will be given to residents of Riverside Road directly west of Pier St.

Duration: 26/03/2020 – 7/04/2020.

Works Include:

- Removal of existing traffic medians and replace with new pavement;
- Removal of existing kerbing along the road;
- Modifications to existing stormwater drainage lids;
- Construction of a limestone retaining wall.

Stage 2

Riverside Road will be closed between the southern end of the Dôme café carpark and Andrews Road. Northern portion of Dôme café carpark to remain closed. Access to be maintained to the southern portion of the Dôme café carpark.

Duration: 8/04/2020 – 17/04/2020.

Works include:

- Removal of existing traffic medians and replace with new pavement;
- Removal of existing kerbing along the road;
- Modifications to existing underground stormwater drainage.

Stage 3

Riverside Road will be closed between East Street and Andrews Road. Northern portion of Dôme café carpark to remain closed.

Duration: 20/04/2020 – 29/04/2020.

Works include:

- Removal of existing traffic medians and replace with new pavement;
- Removal of existing kerbing along the road;
- Modifications to existing underground stormwater drainage;

Stage 4

Riverside Road partial lane closures from the southern end of the Leeuwin boat ramp car park to East Street. Northern portion of Dôme café carpark to remain closed.

Duration: 30/04/2020 – 12/06/2020.

Works Include:

- Stabilisation of pavement;
- Sealing of road;
- Installation of slow points;
- Tree planting
- Installation of a wombat crossing; and
- Installation of signs and lines.

During the construction road closures will be required with signs and detours put in place.

The Town of East Fremantle is confident that the Riverside Road Rehabilitation project will deliver on key community priorities including enhanced safety on local roads for all commuters whether they be pedestrians, cyclists or motorists.
