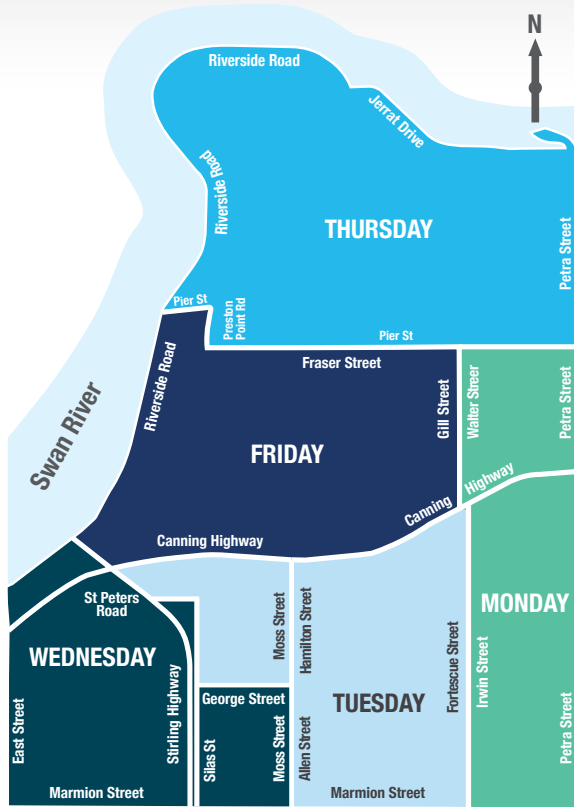

Putting your bins out for collection



Place bins on kerb by 6am on collection day



Maximum weight of each bin is 70kg



Avoid overfilling to ensure lid can close

1m from trees



0.5m between bins



1m from cars, fences, and other items

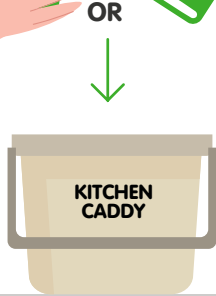
Your kitchen caddy makes sorting your food organics in the kitchen simple.

Residents are eligible for two free packs of compostable liners per financial year, upon presentation of photo ID at the Town Hall, 135 Canning Highway.

Additional liners and kitchen caddies can be purchased from the Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle.



Your food organics and garden organics are turned into compost.

Available from the Fremantle Recycling Centre - \$5 per 25L bag.

Fremantle Recycling Centre

Residents of the Town of East Fremantle have access to the Fremantle Recycling Centre. Upon entry present a current proof of residency, like a driver's licence or rates notice. When dropping off bulk waste items, take your Fremantle Recycling letter and current proof of residency (no commercial access).

Unlimited entry for recyclables listed below (unless otherwise indicated):

- Batteries (vehicle)
- Bread tags
- Can clips
- Cardboard
- Clean and unbroken blocks, bricks, and pavers
- Clean garden organics (up to 1.5m in length and 30cm in diameter, one trailer load per day, fees apply for additional loads)
- Clothing, shoes, and bags (good condition)
- Co-mingled recyclables
- Contact lenses and packaging including plastic film, pods and cardboard packaging (not contact lens solution bottles)
- Cooking oil (up to 20L)
- Electrical appliances and electrical cables
- Electronic waste; computers, TVs and accessories
- Mattresses (fees apply)
- Medicinal blister packs (empty)
- Mobile phones
- Motor oil (up to 20L)
- Plastic bottle lids
- Plastic plant pots
- Polystyrene
- Printer cartridges
- Razor blades and packaging
- Stationary
- Scrap metal
- Textiles and shoes
- Thongs (flip flops)
- Toothbrushes, toothpaste tubes, floss packets and electric toothbrush heads
- Tyres (fees apply)
- Whitegoods
- X-rays.

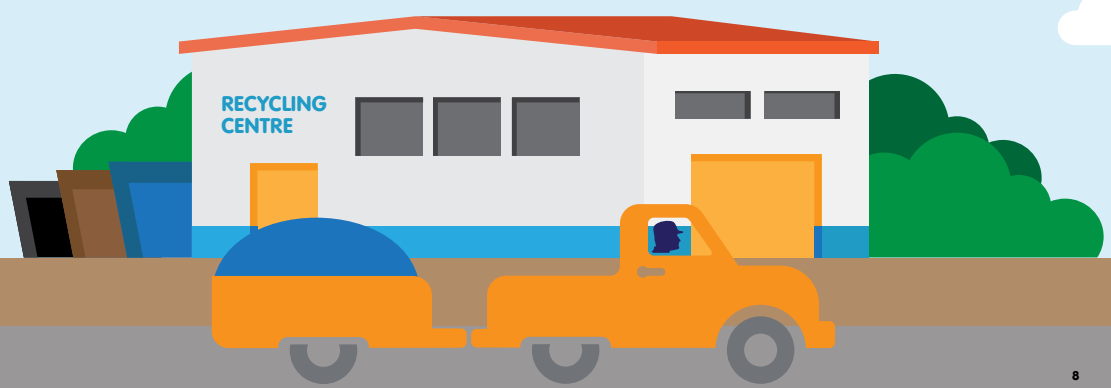

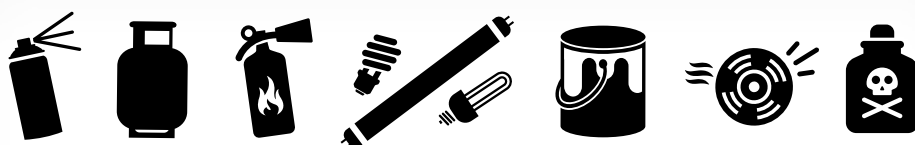

Household Hazardous Waste Facility

Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle

A limit of 20kg or 20 litres per material type.

The following waste materials are covered under the HHW Program:

- Acids
- Aerosols – CFC based
- Aerosols, flammable – paint and lacquers
- Aerosols, flammable – pesticide
- Alkali
- Arsenic based products
- Batteries – household, dry cell
- Cyanides
- Engine coolants and glycols
- Fire extinguishers – non-Halon
- Flammable liquids – hydrocarbons and fuels
- Flammable solids
- Flares
- Fluorescent tubes, CFL and light fittings
- Gas cylinders – other
- Gas cylinders – propane
- General household chemicals e.g., cleaners
- Heavy metal compounds
- Inorganic oxidising agents – e.g., pool chlorine
- Low level radioactive substances e.g., smoke detectors
- Mercury – elemental
- Organic peroxides
- Paint – metal based, other, including isocyanates and amines, recyclable, solvent based, including resins and adhesives, water based
- PCB materials
- Pesticides – non-Schedule X
- Pesticides – Schedule X
- Solvents – halogenated
- Toxics
- Unknown chemicals if they are in a secure, sealed, chemical-resistant container.

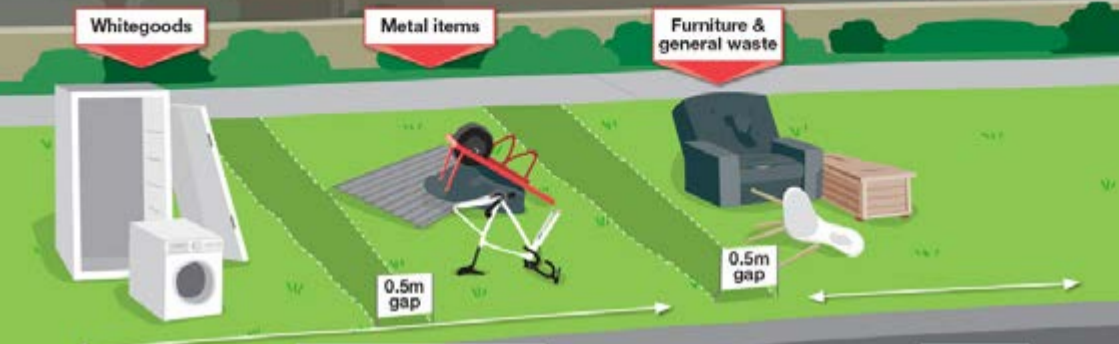
Asbestos, Construction and Demolition (C&D) and Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) can be disposed of for a fee at the following disposal site:

Bulk & White/Metal Goods

Sort waste into 3 separate piles to help us recycle.



Please place your waste on the verge by 6am Monday of the scheduled start dates as the contractor will only service your verge once. Please ensure waste is not placed any earlier than one week prior to collection (only for residential properties).

The following items WILL be collected:

- ✓ Up to 3 cubic metres
- ✓ Items up to 1.5 metres in length
- ✓ Timber products
- ✓ Trampolines and swing sets (disassembled).

Place these items in separate piles:

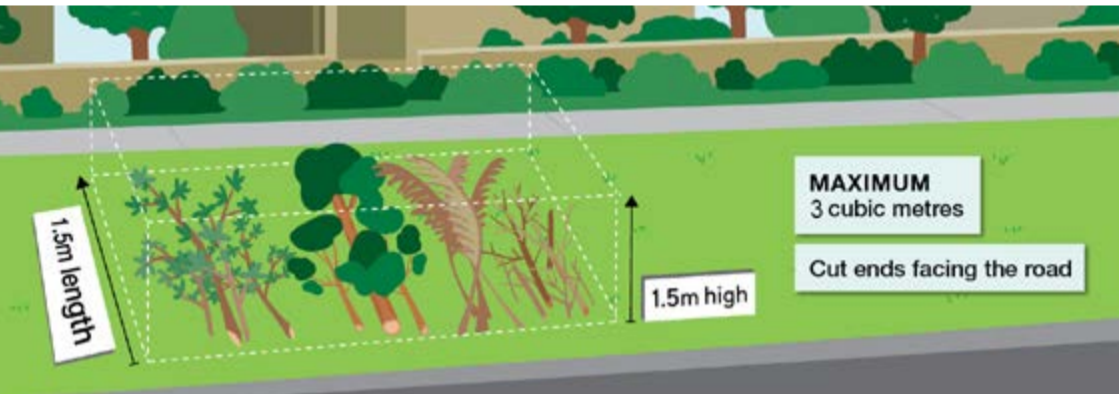
- E-waste
- Mattresses
- White goods (fridge and freezer doors must be removed).

Bulk & White/Metal Goods
Monday 9 October 2023

The following items WILL NOT be collected:

- × NO batteries
- × NO building materials: bricks, tiles, sand, cement
- × NO insulation, plasterboard, concrete, asbestos, fencing
- × NO car bodies, parts or tyres
- × NO food waste or domestic rubbish
- × NO glass including mirrors, tables and furniture with glass panels, shower screens, plate glass, fish tanks/aquariums
- × NO gas cylinders, aerosols or Fire extinguishers
- × NO garden organics: leaves, prunings, dug out lawns, stumps or logs
- × NO paints, chemicals or oils
- × NO wooden pallets.

Green waste can be placed on the verge up to 7 days prior to the collection start date

Bulk Green Waste
Monday 18 September 2023
Monday 11 March 2024

What WILL be collected:

- Tree and shrub prunings up to:
- ✓ Maximum diameter of 30cm (12 inches)
 - ✓ Maximum length of 1.5m (5ft)
 - ✓ Maximum height of pile 1.5m (5ft)
 - ✓ Maximum of 3 cubic metres of green waste.

What WILL NOT be collected:

- × NO boxes or bags of leaves or glass clippings
- × NO dug out lawn, sand or soil
- × NO long branches (over 1.5m)
- × NO garden chemicals, garden pots or reticulation
- × NO general junk
- × NO sawn and treated timber
- × NO green waste placed near services, reticulation, walls or structures
- × NO green waste on vacant land or public reserves.

Bulk green waste can also be disposed of at the Fremantle Recycling Centre, 19a Montreal Street, Fremantle – 1 trailer load per day, proof of residency and Fremantle Recycling letter required on entry. Visit fremantle.wa.gov.au/frc for more information.
