

Parking on a carriageway

Heavy and Long Vehicles

Unless engaged in the picking up or setting down of goods, a person must not park on a carriageway for any period exceeding one hour, a vehicle or any combination of vehicles, that, together with any projection on, or load carried by, the vehicle or combination of vehicles is 7.5 metres or more in length or exceeds a GVM of 3 tonnes.

Nothing in this clause affects the operation of any other clause in this local law, or any other written law relating to the parking or stopping of vehicles.

Should the applicant require access to a verge or thoroughfare for a period greater than an hour, there is an opportunity to apply for the following:

1. Permit for temporary obstruction of a thoroughfare
2. A permit for the temporary use of a public on-street car bay.

at cost to the applicant. These permits are generally only provided where a building permit is issued.
