

Preston Point Road North Recreation Precinct Master Plan

Update #5: 22 January 2020

A master plan is being prepared for the Preston Point Road North Recreation Precinct to enable the Town to effectively plan for the diverse sporting and active recreation requirements of the precinct, in order to best meet the needs of the community.

Actions to date in relation to this project are:

- Successful funding application (Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries).
- Engagement of local consultant, ABV Leisure Consultancy Services (via tender process).
- Local consultation (surveys, meetings, drop-ins and follow up telephone conversations) and analysis process
- Consultation with State Sporting Associations and neighbouring LGAs.
- Research into existing relevant local Plans.
- Assessment of current facilities against the needs of stakeholders, considering industry and sporting / recreation trends, population projections and other impacts.

The most frequent types of use of the Precinct currently are to play formal sport, to walk and for informal recreation. This use is evenly spread over days and times.

There were many “most liked aspects” of the precinct, with the most popular including:

- views and scenery;
- openness and green space;
- proximity to the foreshore; and
- access to sporting club facilities.

2020 Timeline

- 18 February – draft Plan to be presented to Council for endorsement to be advertised for Public Comment.
- 21 February – draft Plan released for Public Comment (comments to be received by 4pm, Friday 20 March).
- 25 February – precinct user breakfast forum.
- 21 April – proposed final Plan to be presented to Council for endorsement.
