

Leeuwin Accommodation Demolition Project

Dear Residents

Please be aware that there will be demolition works occurring from December 2022 to January 2023 at Leeuwin Barracks, East Fremantle. The project works include the demolition of three end-of-life accommodation buildings at Leeuwin Barracks. The 3-story accommodation buildings will be demolished from the top down, with excavators being used primarily to conduct the demolition activities.

Please note that these demolition activities are not reflective of any change in the currently suspended divestment for Leeuwin Barracks. Defence continues to study the long-term Defence estate requirements in the Perth and Fremantle region and will inform the community once a decision has been reached.

Anticipated construction period:

5 to 23 December

- The first week activities will predominantly focus on the dismantling of the buildings.
- The following weeks in December will involve the rubble being loaded into trucks and carried off-site.

2 to 13 January

- Works will resume in January to clean and restore the site. This will involve supplying fill to the area and compaction of the site.

Daily Truck Movements

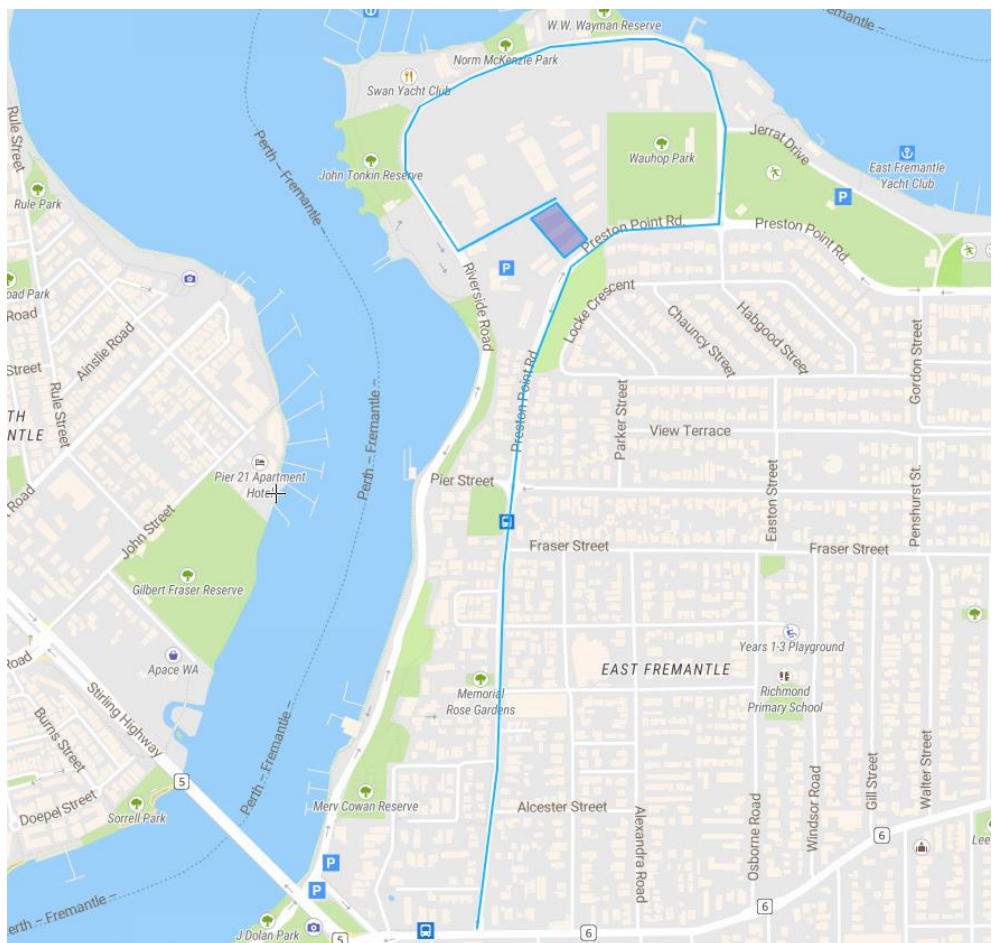
- During the demolition works in December: up to 10 trucks per day
- During the infill works in January: up to 10 trucks per day

Hours of day works will be occurring

- 0700 – 1700 weekdays only

Noise impact of the works

- The demolition activities will result in increased noise levels from the site for the duration of the works.
