This month we have a Cycling Without Age experience for anyone who fancies; would you like to have a ride on a specially built trishaw e-bike along the waters of Point Walter? You'd be one of two passengers seated in the trishaw cabin piloted by a volunteer cyclist. The concept originated in Copenhagen, Denmark, through a man called Ole Kassow. It's about older people having adventure, joy and freedom through cycling. It started in 2012 and has spread to about 42 countries. We plan to show you the documentary of its build, and the reaction of the people participating, which led its worldwide spread.

On Wednesday 7 May Outing & Centre Groups meet for morning tea and music performances with troubadours Jono, on harmonica, & Paddy (this time with microphone to hear her beautiful vocals), and Jake Minear, who invites you to join him and have fun singing some Elvis songs. Jake goes from Marty Robbins' 'A White Sports Coat (and a Pink Carnation)' to white suit with glitter.

We honour mums at Manning Seniors Centre and at the Deck Club on the 14th.

We have a visit planned to Wheelchairs For Kids, a very special place, a factory in Wangara, operated completely by volunteers. Since 1998 the factory designs, builds and distributes 'rough terrain' wheelchairs for children with disability around the world at no cost to them. The factory has often had wait listing for volunteers who wish to donate time and expertise at the workshop.
