

Project Update: Schematic Building and Precinct Design

Redevelopment of this Precinct is being actioned as a priority major project

The development of an Integrated Community, Sport and Leisure Precinct within the Town at the East Fremantle Oval precinct will provide significant economic, social and health benefits.

The Process So Far...

Phase 1, Visioning, 2018-2019.

During this extensive consultation and co-design process, the community expressed strong support for upgrades to club facilities, passive recreation space for walking (including with dogs), general exercise activities, enhanced access to club sports and recreation activities. Interest was also expressed in adding a shed activity space, a fitness facility, casual shared-use hard courts, a nature play space, flexible outdoor community event space, a modest skate park, a function room / café and multi-purpose areas for performances.

Phase 2, Business Planning.

In early 2020 the vision was developed and refined, in collaboration with expert consultants, to prepare a high-level concept design to support the drafting of a business plan and funding document.

Next Steps

Phase 3, Schematic Design.

Following the appointment of a Multidisciplinary Design Team (MDT), an updated Concept Design will be released for community information and review.

- Workshop 1 - Wednesday 23 September 2020, 3.30pm, East Fremantle Town Hall
- Workshop 2 - Wednesday 23 September 2020, 5.30pm, East Fremantle Town Hall

The design will then be displayed online and at the Town Hall, with public comments sought by mail or email between 23 to 30 September 2020.

The MDT will prepare a draft Schematic Design following a review of feedback. The community will then have the opportunity to view this draft design:

- Drop In Session - Wednesday 14 October 2020, 3.30pm to 7.30pm, East Fremantle Town Hall.

The revised design will then be open to public comment from 8 to 16 October 2020. The Building and Precinct Schematic Design will be finalised by the MDT following their review of additional feedback.

Council are mindful of the significance of the project and its importance to the community. Consultation has been extensive throughout the process and to date community feedback has been overwhelmingly positive. One resident succinctly captured the community feeling in a dozen words, *'This is a once in a lifetime opportunity to get this right'*.
