Stay in the Loop with your Community Park

It's been a busy few months since the doors opened at the East Fremantle Community Park. The B Active gym is pumping with users while Carnaby's Café, Bar and Restaurant have launched a series of specials including Quiz Nights and meal deals.

In June, the Town invited residents to share feedback on a proposed Dog Exercise Area at the park. Thank you to everyone who provided comment.

The Town received over 30 submissions as part of the consultation, with most of the respondents positive in anticipation of the opening.

Your comments helped to inform Council's decision to endorse the new Dog Exercise Area.

Boasting 4000 sqm of grass, the area can be accessed off Allen Street and offers a safe, fun and spacious environment for

dogs of all sizes and breeds to run, play and socialise. There are also two bench seats, a bin for pet litter and a drink fountain.

Residents are encouraged to use the area responsibly, ensuring all dogs remain under their owner's full control at all times. Owners are required to carry a leash to promptly manage their dogs as needed.

There are now six dog exercise areas in the Town of East Fremantle.

Coastal Hazards Risk Management Adaptation Plan endorsed

Recently, Council endorsed a Coastal Hazard Risk Management and Adaptation Plan (CHRMAP).

The CHRMAP identifies key assets along the river foreshore and the measures we will take to preserve

them against the impact of coastal hazards, such as erosion and inundation.

Register your bike on Bikelinc

Did you know that each year hundreds of bicycles are stolen from homes, schools, and workplaces?

While WAPOL and our Rangers do manage to recover many stolen bikes, Crime Stoppers WA's Bikelinc program can help return your bike to you.

Bikelinc is a free online data system where owners can record:

- Their name and address
- Bicycle frame and serial number
- Bicycle make, model and colour
- Date and place of purchase

WAPOL can use these details to conduct random inspection of bikes pawned at pawn brokers and allows Rangers to check bike registration numbers online and notify the police.
