Waste and Recycling Information



FOGO BIN (LIME GREEN LID) Collected Weekly

- Garden waste
- Vegetable and fruit waste
- Lawn clippings, branches and prunings
- Meat products and bones
- All cooked and uncooked food
- All dairy products (milk, cheese and yoghurt)
- Paper and cardboard
- Shredded paper
- Soiled tissues and paper towel
- Pet waste
- Kitty litter
- Dog poo (in yellow compostable poo bags available from parks in the Town)

No plastic, degradable or OXO degradable bags or liners (compostable liners only or wrap your food waste in newspaper).



RECYCLING (YELLOW LID) Collected Fortnightly

- Paper (excluding shredded paper)
- Cardboard (flattened)
- Glass bottles and jars (including broken glass)
- Aluminium and steel cans/tins
- Newspapers, magazines and junk mail
- Plastic containers & bottles

Items should be CLEAN, EMPTY, with LIDS REMOVED and placed LOOSE in the bin. **NO BAGGED RECYCLING.**

GENERAL WASTE BIN (RED LID) Collected Fortnightly
