## FIRE AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN

**Fire Extinguisher / Fire Blanket** – On arrival please take note of the location of the fire extinguisher and fire blanket within the pantry. Guests are asked to use these in the instance of a fire that they believe they can safely contain themselves.

There are smoke detectors installed, please do not touch or remove these under any circumstances.

Call 000 in case of a life-threatening emergency - Fire, Police, Ambulance.

Once emergency services are on their way please contact the Property Manager, Anna Hanson on 0404 355 403 and notify her of the situation.

**Barbecue and Gas** - There is a Weber BBQ located under the stairs or the main house for outdoor cooking. Gas bottles are checked regularly to ensure ample gas for our guests as well as they are in safe operating order.

When you have finished cooking please turn the gas off at the bottle to ensure there are no accidents.

**First Aid Kit** – A First Aid Kit can be found under the sink in the bathroom / laundry. Please notify the Property Manager if anything is used so it can be restocked for the next guests.
