

Temporary Parking Solution – George Street

Due to the construction work being undertaken at 90 George Street and following some concerns by local businesses about access to their premises, the Town of East Fremantle has installed Parking signs to identify the 15 bays which are now designated “1 hour parking” Monday to Friday 6am to 6pm and on Saturday between 8am and 3pm.

Residents and businesses within that ‘zone’ have received temporary parking permits to ‘override’ the 1 hour limit.

The Town has also negotiated the provision of additional parking (approximately 14 spaces) at the end of King Street.

Alternate/Additional Parking – cnr King Street and St Peters Street

Thanks to the cooperation of Main Roads WA we have arranged for temporary additional parking in the area bounded by St Peters Road and King Street is available. See the diagram below.

Town of East Fremantle Rangers will continue to monitor parking and traffic management in the area.



Integrated Traffic Management Online Survey
